Session structure



- We will present to the audience the pre-recorded video of the lectures
- After we finish displaying the video we will start the Q&A discussion
- The session moderator will address questions to the speakers
- The speaker to whom the question was addressed to, will answer the question with his/her microphone



General instructions for the speakers



- Please join the zoom meeting at least 20 minutes before the Q&A panel will start. The exact time will be given by the Project Manager from Kenes, when they send the zoom link.
- Please make sure that you have a good microphone. We recommend using a headset like this if possible:





General instructions for the speakers



- Please make sure to connect with a webcam
- Please make sure that you are in quiet place
- When you are not speaking please mute your microphone, don't forget to unmute when you want to talk
- It's possible to communicate with the other speakers over the zoom chat during the session, the audience can't see the chat
- Please make sure to connect to the zoom with your actual name, because the audience will be able to see the faculty names in the live streaming
- If no-one asks a question, the moderator should try to engage the Q&A session with their own questions. These should be prepared in advanced



Connect via phone to the Q&A and helpdesk support



- Together with the zoom link we will also send a zoom telephone number that will be valid for most of Europe, USA and Canada. You will be able to dial in to the meeting if your internet or computer stops working. You will be able to hear the meeting via your phone.
- We will also send a telephone number of the helpdesk team that will be able to help you in real time to connect to the live section if you are having any issues.
